- c1935 12 pages plus Buff cover which has Black Printing and red stars and lines, 6 solos and 3 tandems listed including Brilliant 1 & 2, DeLux, Superb and Ideal. Order form printed in. (Vertical Format)
- c1935/36 12 pages plus cover, cover similar to above. 7 ....Models, Brilliant no1 and No2, Competition, Superb Road. De Luxe, Ideal and Ladies De Luxe. 3 tandems, De luxe, Ideal No1 and Brilliant. Brilliant No2 includes Reynolds 531 Tubing. Separate order form. (Vertical Format).
- 1937 12 pages plus Mid Blue Cover with black printing, dated Season 1937. 6 Solos and 2 Tandems listed, Competition Road, Brilliant No2, Anglo Continental, Super Sprinter, Olympic and the Brilliant and Olympic Tandems (Horizontal Format)
- 1938 16 pages plus cover dated Season 1938. 8 solos and 2 Tandems. Models listed, Competition Road, Brilliant Nos. 1, 2 and 3, "Anglo Continental", "Tour de France", "Toni Merkens" Model, Super Sprinter, and the Brilliant and Shrt Wheel-Base Tandems. (Horizontal Format).
- 1940 20 pages plus cover includes Anglo Continental, 'Toni Merkens, etc. Two tandems Brilliant and Competition Short wheel-base Tandem. V 4 pages of descriptive text. All frames Reynolds 531 Tubing. (Horizontal Format).
- c1940 As above but with new introductory page showing Headbadge and with notice at foot of page increasing prices by 12 1/2%. contents as 1940.
- c1946 *Orange cover with Green Printing* showing three riders by W K Bicknell, 12 pages plus order form and cover, Includes Super Special, Six Day, Massed Start No 1 and Toni Merkins Model. (Horizontal Format)
- c1949 Cover unknown. Models listed include: 'Toni Merkens', Six Day and the new Magnum Opus, Nulli Secundus and Experto Crede. (Horizontal Format).
- 1951 Three page leaflet printed black on white paper. Cover shows three riders by W K Bicknell. Four models listed, Manum Opus, Magnum Bonum, Nulli Secundus, and Experto Crede. Nine different frame designs listed. (Vertical format).
- c1953 Cover showing three riders, green cover with blue printing. 8 pages and cover, pages yellow with green printing, 5 models Magnum Opus, Magnum Bonum, Nilli Secundus, Experto Crede and Vade Mecum. (Vertical Format)
- c1956 Black Printing on Red Cover, similar to 5 but Experto Crede Cast Lugs listed and some price increases. (vertical Format).
- c 1960 Cover showing three riders pale blue with dark blue printing, 8 pages plus cover. 7 models as 1956 plus the Brilliant and The Plus. (Vertical Format Format)
- c1962 Cover showing three riders, cream with black printing. opening leaflet with 8 sides. Lists Experto Crede with both cast and pressed lugs, Mountain King, Nulli Secundus, Magnum Bonum, Magnum Opus, The Plus, Track Supreme, and Vade Mecum (Vertical Format Format)
- c1964 Cover showing three riders, cover pink with black printing, 8 pages plus cover. Models listed, Italia, Vade Mecum Mk 1, Experto Crede, Mountain King, Vade Mecum II, Mountain King De Lux, Experto Crede Plus, Vade Mecum Mk III, Nulli Secundus, Magnum Bonum, and Magnum Opus. Also includes Track Supreme some printings have the illustrations for the Mountain King Deluxe on page 1 and the Vade Mecum MkII on page 4 reversed and can cause confusion. (Vertical Format)

- c1985 Folded Card with pocket to hold price list. Front cover shows close up of head badge. Mainly black with 3 frame sets illustrated. Magnum Opus, Novus Ductor and Scorpion Bonum. The lugs are in red and the frame tubes are black. Complete frame shown on pocket
- c1988 Two page pamphlet in full colour, one side shows and Magnum Opus in Black and Red fitted with DURA-ACE components. On the reverse are three frame sets and detail pictures. Models listed are Magnum Opus, Novus Ductor and Scorpion Bonum. (Vertical Format)
- c1992 Single page, one side is illustrated with the stand from 1935 Lightweight Show and now carries Jacksons address at Leeds. On the reverse are 3 framesets and 2 detail pictures. Models listed are Magnum Opus, Scorpion Bonum and Novus Ductor. (Horizontal Format)
- c1992 Double page Side one shows Magnum Opus, the stand at the Lightweight Show and a Hetchins Cycle being raced. The other side shows frames and details and now includes a Tandem frame, models listed are Magnum Opus, Scorpion Bonum and Novus Ductor. (Horizontal Format)
